 Oct. 25: Elementary, middle school conferences, 5-8 p.m.  
 Oct. 26: Elementary, middle school conferences, 12-8 p.m. (no school for elementary, middle school students)

Oct. 27: No school for elementary, middle school students or teachers  
 Oct. 27: High-school professional development – no school for high-school students

Nov. 9: Elem Early Release-1:30 p.m.  
 Nov. 22-24: Thanksgiving break (no school)

Dec. 14: Elem Early Release-1:30 p.m.  
 Dec. 22: End of first semester (half day for students and teachers)  
 Dec. 25-29: Winter break (no school)

Jan. 1: New Year's Day - Winter break (no school)  
 Jan. 2: Elementary work / professional development; middle and high-school teacher work day (no school for students)  
 Jan. 11: Elem Early Release-1:30 p.m.  
 Jan. 15: Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (no school)

Feb. 8: Elem Early Release-1:30 p.m.  
 Feb. 14-15: High-school conferences, 5-8 p.m.  
 Feb. 16: No school for high-school students or teachers  
 Feb. 19: Presidents Day (no school)

March 8: Elem Early Release-1:30 p.m.  
 March 15: End of third quarter  
 March 16: Teacher work day (no school for students)  
 March 19-23: Spring break (no school)

April 12: Elem Early Release-1:30 p.m.  
 April 13: No School

May 10: Elem Early Release-1:30 p.m.  
 May 23: Last day of school, depending on snow days (half day for students, full day for teachers)

June 1: Tentative start day for summer school, depending on snow days

If the district cancels school for snow days, students will make up those days at the end of the year. Those days could include May 24, 25, 29, 30, 31, and June 1 plus any additional days as needed.
